#### 5. <u>BUSINESS ITEMS:</u>

A. Election Slate for Fiscal Years 2022-2024 per policy number 4040.30.

Following discussion to retain the existing officers in their current positions, **Trustee Tashiro moved to approve the decision as presented, Trustee Carbone seconded;** the motion passed unanimously.

# B. Consideration and Approval of Central Coast Sign and Design quote to add signage to new building.

Manger Klemme presented the Board with various signage preferences and costs. He will ask for sample colors before approving selections.

# C. Consideration and Approval of Aerial Services quote to provide drone treatment support during busy season.

Manager Klemme relayed background information to the Board regarding the District's experience and relationship with Aerial Services as well as the company shutdown of our former pesticide applicator.

Without further inquiries, **Trustee Goetzelt moved to approve the Aerial Services quote as presented, Trustee Tashiro seconded;** the motion passed unanimously.

### D. Discuss Dick Shanahan's analysis of abatement powers.

General discussion was had regarding the District vs. homeowners responsibilities and our power to enforce homeowners to comply with our abatement assessments in extreme cases. Manager Klemme will have the District's attorney review Shanahan's analysis to move forward on adding a compliance policy.

## E. Approval of change to Policy Number 2350 Seasonal Mosquito Tech

Manager Klemme informed the Board of recent retirements and his preference of hiring seasonal workers to assist technicians where needed.

Without further inquiries, **Trustee Goetzelt moved to approve the Aerial Services quote as presented, Trustee Campbell seconded;** the motion passed unanimously.

Manager Klemme updated the Board on the progress of the new facility, including PG & E delays. He also apprised them of the status of the annual Mosquito & Vector Control conference in that it will be in person in Sacramento February 7<sup>th</sup> through the 10<sup>th</sup>.
